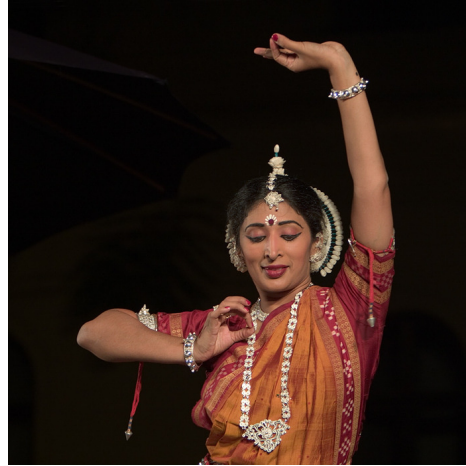

**Odissi** is one of the eight classical dance forms of India. It originates from the state of Orissa, in eastern India. It is the oldest surviving dance form of India on the basis of archaeological evidences.

**Sandhyadipa Kar** is from a family of renowned artists of Orissa, India. Her grandfather, Pandit Khetramohan Kar was a noted Tabla-maestro of Puri and her father, Shri Prafulla Kar is a well know music director, singer and lyricist. Sandhyadipa began her training in Odissi dance in 1982 under the tutelage of Padma Bibhusan Late Guru Shri Kelucharan Mohapatra. She has since performed on numerous occasions in both India and Abroad.
