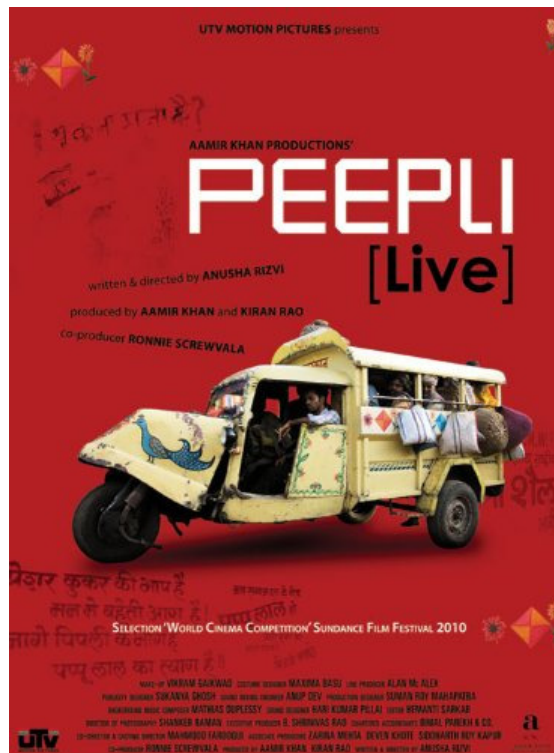

Peepli Live is a comic satire that explores the issue of farmer suicides and the subsequent media and political response. Natha, a poor farmer from Peepli, a small Indian village, is about to lose the family land due to an unpaid loan. His brother, Budhia, hears about a government programme offering the family of any farmer committing suicide a compensation of ₹ 100,000. Budhia then tries to push Natha to commit suicide in order to win the land back with the compensation money. This starts a chain of events around Natha involving the local government in electoral campaign and TV channels covering the “suicide attempt”.

The movie will be screened in original Hindi, with English subtitles. The running time of the movie is 104 minutes.
